# Sponsorship Opportunities!

## Show Sponsor: \$250+

*Description: Show sponsorship helps us pay for the performance rights for the show. Show sponsors will be listed on the front of the program, and they will receive reserved seating, 4 free tickets to the fall show and 4 free tickets to the spring show, as well as tickets for concession items (4 per show). A family who brings a show sponsor has covered their production costs for the 2019-2020 year.*

## **Gold Level Sponsor \$100-\$249.**

*Description: Gold Level Sponsors receive their names in the program for both fall and spring productions, reserved seating at fall and spring shows, 2 free tickets per production, a cast photo, and the costume fee waived for 1 student.*

## **Blue Level Sponsor \$50-\$99**

*Description: Blue Level Sponsors will receive their family/business name in the program and reserved seating at all shows, and 4 free concession tickets per show (no admission tickets included).*

## Line Sponsor: \$5 each

*Description: Line sponsorships are a great, affordable way to give a "shout out" to your favorite performer or group of performers! Each shout-out costs just \$5.00 and is printed in our program. **Order forms for line sponsors will be sent home separately with students in the weeks immediately preceding a show.***

Christmas Greens Fundraiser



Help our students and theatre raise funds for our fall Christmas shows and our spring musical, Shrek, Jr.!

Students: Each item you sell goes toward your production costs! Any extra sales go directly toward our theatre program to help us purchase costumes, props, set pieces, lights, sound equipment, etc. This fundraiser has the potential to really help us grow!

Who could you sell to? Family members, friends, neighbors (whom you know), and even businesses. These are real pine products, made from the pine trees on Sherwood Forest Farms in Washington (state). They are beautiful and will be perfect for holiday decorating.

How much are the items?: They range from \$15-\$80, depending upon your choice for delivery.

How much will Hazelwood Theatre Arts make? We make up to 50% from each item!

How do you collect orders? Take the catalogue and ask others to support our theatre program by making a purchase. Have them fill-out the order form on your envelope and give you cash or a check for that amount. There are two delivery options, so make sure you are writing on the correct side of the envelope!

**Local Delivery (green side of the envelope): These are for people who you can deliver the items to yourself when they come in. The items are cheaper because they will be shipped to Hazelwood, then you will take them to whomever ordered from you.**

**Direct Delivery (red side of the envelope) is for friends and family members who live farther away from you. This allows the items to be delivered by a mail service (UPS/FedEX, etc.) directly to their houses. The extra cost includes the delivery fee.**

**All orders must be brought back to Mrs. Haulter no later than Friday, Nov. 8<sup>th</sup>. The Christmas items will be ready for pick-up at the school during the first week of December (parents will receive a notification when the items are ready for pick-up, and students will not be able to carry them home).**
